

## Is Your Laundry Room Lease Clean?

- **1. Don't get locked in for too long** The industry average for a laundry room lease is between seven and ten years. Be wary of vendors that offer enticing incentives in return for longer lease. If their products and services are exceptional, they should have the confidence in their ability to renew short-term leases.
- **2. Beware of one-sided automatic renewals—** These one-sided clauses favour the vendor by automatically renewing at the end of the term. Keep control in your hands and your options open.
- **3. Deny their right of first refusal** Vendors sometimes try to slip into a lease their right to first refusal, which essentially allows them to extend your lease as long as they match the financial term of any competitive bid even if you are unhappy with their products and service.
- **4. Say "no" to price control** Some vendors seek to set and control washer and dryer prices, but you have the right to have a say in what you charge your residents in your facilities.
- **5. Take a long term view of bonus money** Upfront bonus money is undeniably alluring, but there is a trade-off. A bigger front end bonus comes at the expense of smaller monthly commissions. Be sure to review your options to find out what best suits your needs.
